



### Guidelines for Reviews

- Only reviews of published works in the previous two years are considered;
- the editorial staff should be notified in advance of prospective reviews, in order to prevent concurrent reviews;
- reviews should not exceed 1000 words;
- the reviewer's name and institutional affiliation should follow the review;
- The bibliographical reference should be as follows:

**AUTHOR** (Year), *Title. Subtitle.* (series name and volume number), place of publication, publisher, pages. ISBN or ISSN (current price).
