



INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE *THE CARMELITES IN THE LUSO-HISPANIC WORLD*

History, Art and Heritage

(19-22 July 2017)

More than eight centuries after the founding of the Order of Carmel, and over four centuries after the establishment of the Order of the Discalced Carmelites, the *Sociedade de Geografia de Lisboa* (*Geographical Society of Lisbon*) is promoting¹ an International Conference dedicated to the activity of the Carmelites in the Luso-Hispanic world, from the perspective of history, art and heritage. The Conference will take place between 19 and 22 July, and will bring together contributions of researchers and interested parties, focusing on the following thematic areas:

After appraisal by the Scientific Board the authors will be duly notified by April 30, 2017.

With the objective of having the texts to be available as of this year in a volume with the proofs for the authors' to revise before the Conference, the definitive texts must be submitted by 20 June.

The official languages of the Conference are Portuguese, Spanish, Italian, French and English. The definitive programme will be available after 15 June.

Other initiatives planned in the ambit of this Conference include two expositions, one in the *National Archives of the Torre do Tombo* and another in the *Biblioteca Nacional*, as well as visits to the *Museu Nacional de Arte Antiga* [Museum of Ancient Art] and to the *Associação dos Arqueólogos Portugueses* [Association of Portuguese Archaeologists].
